High speed Internet is free at Willamette University and TIUA. You do not need to pay for Internet access. Follow the instructions at the links below to connect your notebook computer to the Willamette University network and the internet.

ResNet: wired Internet in your room: LAN cable is required

Anti-VIRUS (ウイルス)

Willamette University **REQUIRES** that anti-virus software be installed on any computer that is connected to their network. This includes **YOUR** notebook computer!

If you do not yet have any anti-virus software on your computer

Most anti-virus programs require you to pay a yearly subscription fee for virus definition updates. Willamette University offers free Symantec Anti-virus.

1. Download a free (no cost to Willamette/TIUA students) copy of Symantec Antivirus from Willamette University at: <http://www.willamette.edu/wits/virus/software.htm>
2. Install Symantec Antivirus by double-clicking on the file you downloaded in step 2 above.

If you already have anti-virus software on your computer

You have **two** options:

1. Continue to use the anti-virus software installed on your computer. If you choose this option you must make sure your **virus definitions are current**. This will most likely mean **renewing (paying for)** your anti-virus program's virus-definition subscription.
2. **Uninstall** your current anti-virus software and download/install a free (no cost to Willamette/TIUA students) copy of Symantec Antivirus from Willamette University at: <http://www.willamette.edu/wits/virus/software.htm>.

SPYWARE (スパイウェア)

Spyware (also called "adware" or "malware") is unwanted software that may be harmful to your computer. It is a common problem at Willamette University and TIUA. You can protect your computer from spyware by installing an anti-spyware program (similar to an anti-virus program).

TIUA recommends the anti-spyware program called "Spybot – Search & Destroy." This program has a Japanese language option available. You can download Spybot at this website:

E-MAIL (電子メール)

TIUA recommends using **Willamette Webmail** for reading your Willamette e-mail on your notebook computer.

HOME DIRECTORY (H: ドライブ)

Each student has a "home directory" on a Willamette University server(also called the **H:\ Drive**) for saving computer files. You can use your home directory in the computer labs, and also on your notebook computer.

How to connect to your home directory on a Windows XP:

1. Click on **Start (スタート)**, and then select **My Computer (マイ コンピュータ)**.
2. Click on **Tools (ツールズ)**, then select **Map Network Drive (マップ ネットワーク ドライブ)**
3. For **Drive (ドライブ)**, select the letter **H:**
4. For **Folder (フォルダ)**, type: **\\home<your Willamette userid>**
(example: **\\home\skazuki**). If when you type "\ " and you see "¥" instead that is OK.
5. Click **Finish (終わり)**
6. You may be asked for your Willamette userid and password. If so, type these in and press the *Enter* key.
7. You should now be connected to your H: drive (home directory).
